

GOOD NEWS FOR PARENTS!

The new Child Tax Credit means more families are eligible to receive more support through December 2021.



Most families are eligible to receive the full, improved Child Tax Credit.

Households consisting of joint filers making up to \$150,000, a single head of household making up to \$112,500, or a single filer making up to \$75,000 qualify for the full advanced monthly payment of the credit.

Families with no income are eligible to receive the full credit.

\$3,600

for children under 6

Monthly payments go directly to families each month (July-Dec 2021).

\$3,000

for children ages 6 to 17

\$250 to \$300 per month

Families will receive the remaining \$1,800 or \$1,500 after filing 2021 federal taxes in early 2022.

Payments will not affect other benefits, such as SNAP or Medicaid.
