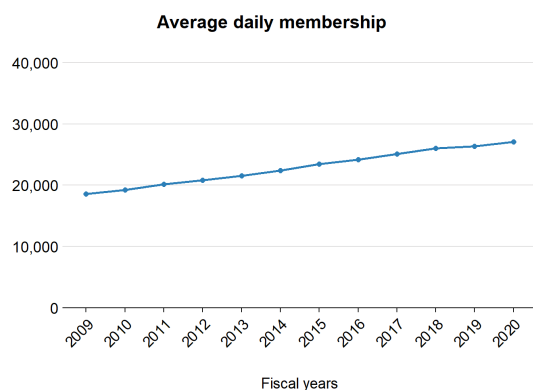


Arlington Public Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Arlington Public Schools.

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **up** by **45.9%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Arlington Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Arlington Public Schools.

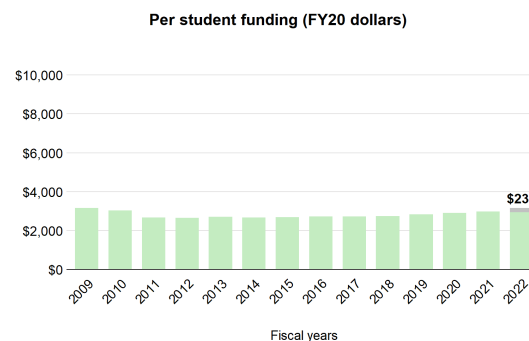
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 371 more teachers and instructors
- 366 more support staff
- 17 more school counselors and librarians
- 97 more teacher aides
- 25 more principals and assistant principals

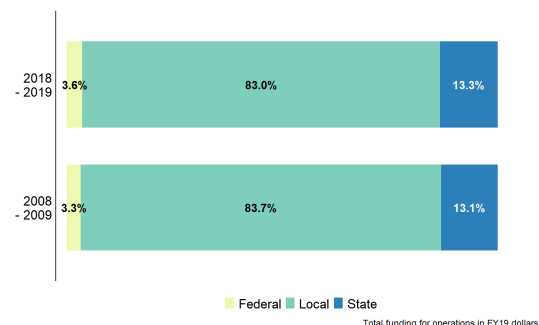
That's **877 more** staff overall, compared to **8,117 more** students.

Funding

In Arlington Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **decreased** by **7.2%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$230 additional dollars per student.*



From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
