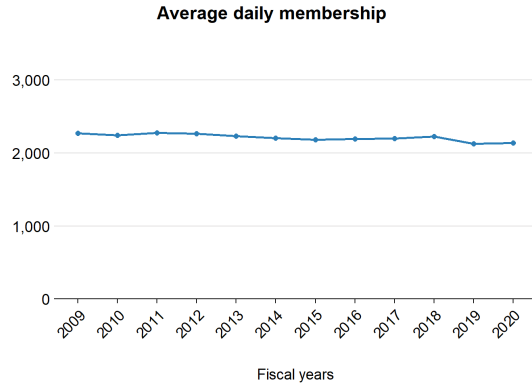


Bristol Virginia Public Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Bristol Virginia Public Schools.

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **down** by **5.9%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Bristol Virginia Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now more staff per student in Bristol Virginia Public Schools.

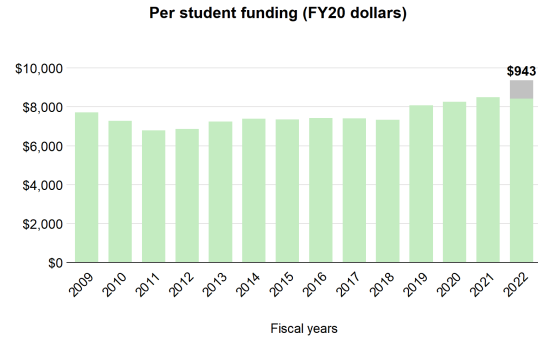
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 20 fewer teachers and instructors
- 27 more support staff
- 1 fewer school counselors and librarians
- 14 more teacher aides
- 1 fewer principals and assistant principals

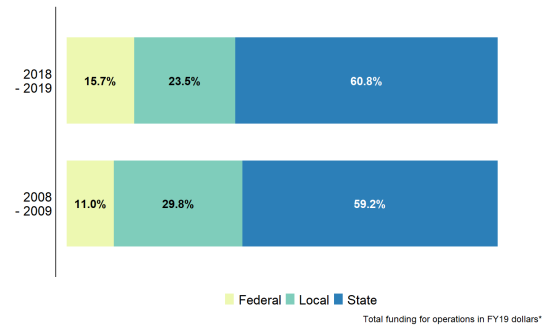
That's **19 more** staff overall, compared to **137 fewer** students.

Funding

In Bristol Virginia Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **9.2%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$943 additional dollars per student.*



From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
