

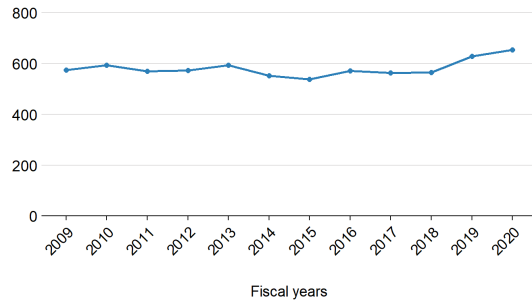
# Colonial Beach Public Schools

## Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **up** by **13.7%**.

## Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Colonial Beach Public Schools.

In 2018-2019, there were:

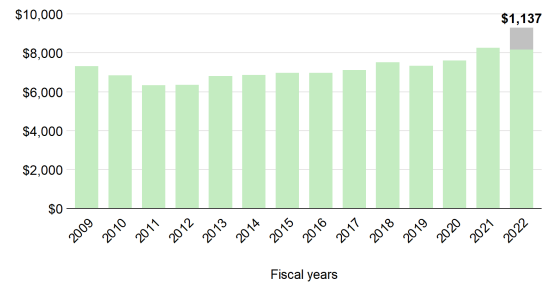
- 1 fewer teachers and instructors
- 3 more support staff
- 1 fewer school counselors and librarians
- 0 more teacher aides
- 0 more principals and assistant principals

That's **2 more** staff overall, compared to **68 more** students.

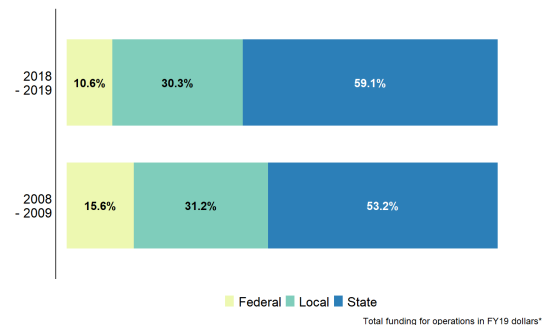
## Funding

In Colonial Beach Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **11.5%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$1,137 additional dollars per student.*
