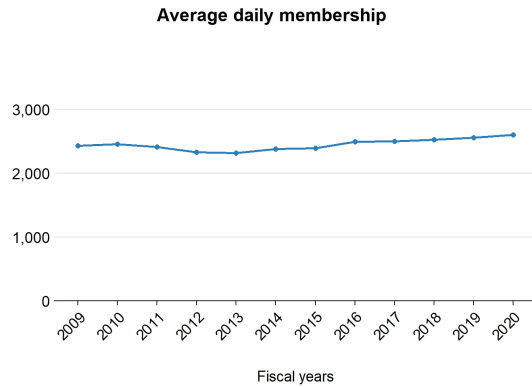


Goochland County Public Schools

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **up** by **7.1%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Goochland County Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Goochland County Public Schools.

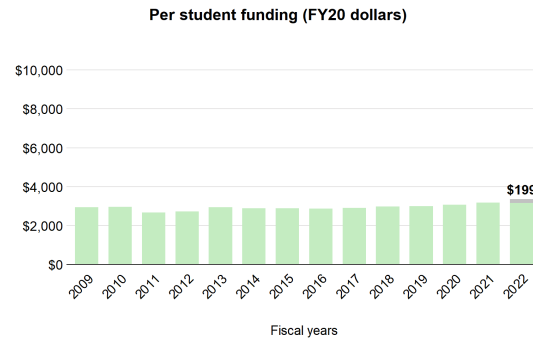
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 10 more teachers and instructors
- 10 fewer support staff
- 1 more school counselors and librarians
- 20 fewer teacher aides
- 0 more principals and assistant principals

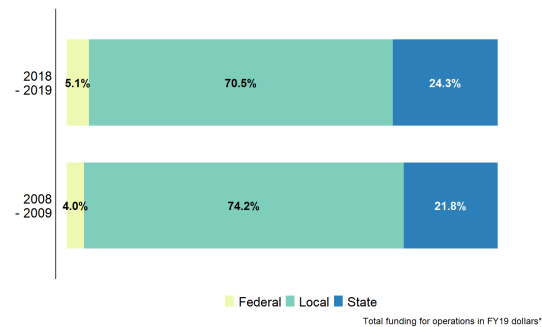
That's **19 fewer** staff overall, compared to **215 more** students.

Funding

In Goochland County Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **6.9%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$199 additional dollars per student.*



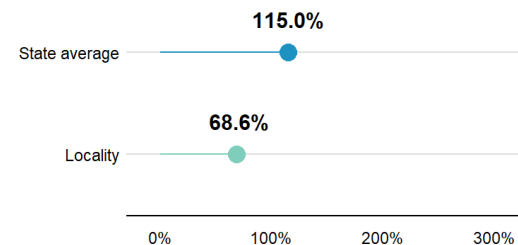
From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
