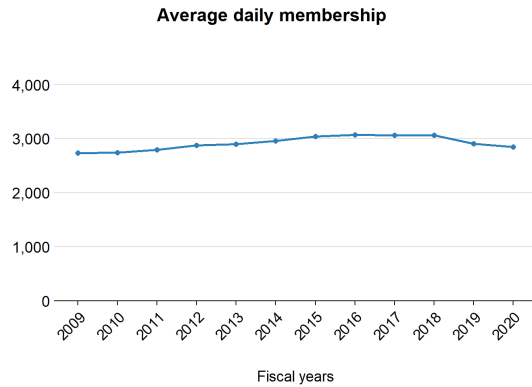


# Greene County Public Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Greene County Public Schools.

## Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **up** by **4%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Greene County Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

## Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Greene County Public Schools.

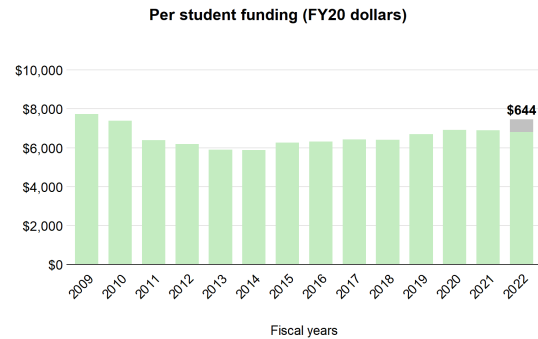
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 10 fewer teachers and instructors
- 7 fewer support staff
- 1 more school counselors and librarians
- 26 fewer teacher aides
- 0 more principals and assistant principals

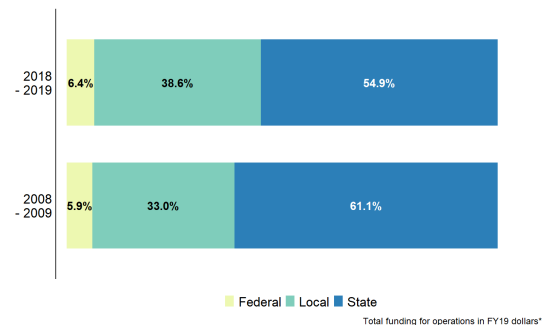
That's **41 fewer** staff overall, compared to **178 more** students.

## Funding

In Greene County Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **decreased** by **11.9%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$644 additional dollars per student.*



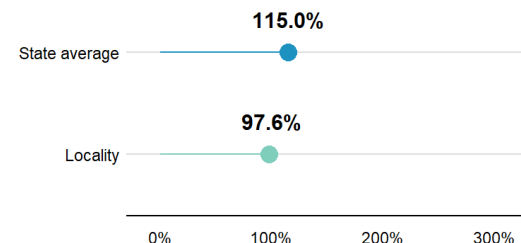
From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **decreased**.
