

# Loudoun County Public Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Loudoun County Public Schools.

## Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **up** by **50.5%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Loudoun County Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

## Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Loudoun County Public Schools.

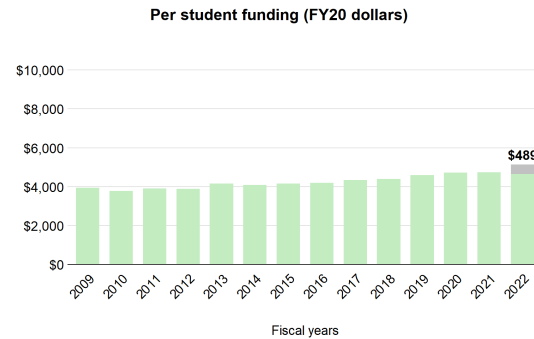
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 1,546 more teachers and instructors
- 1,058 more support staff
- 78 more school counselors and librarians
- 269 more teacher aides
- 149 more principals and assistant principals

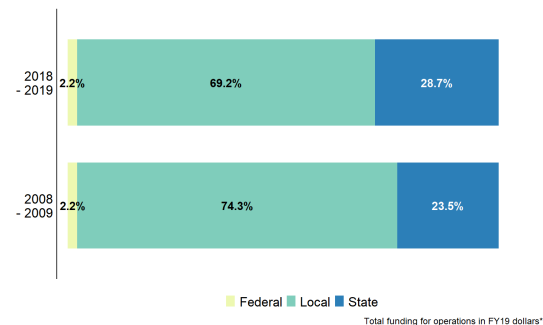
That's **3,100 more** staff overall, compared to **25,058 more** students.

## Funding

In Loudoun County Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **18%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$489 additional dollars per student.*



From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
