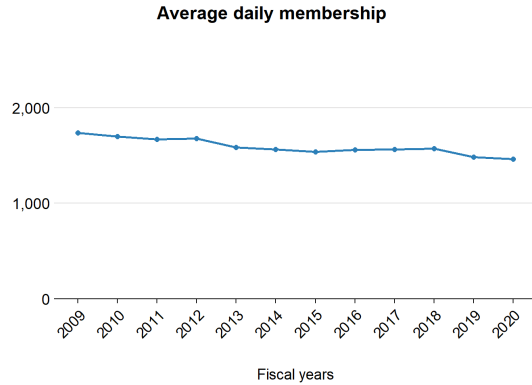


# Northampton County Public Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Northampton County Public Schools.

## Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **down** by **15.9%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Northampton County Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

## Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now more staff per student in Northampton County Public Schools.

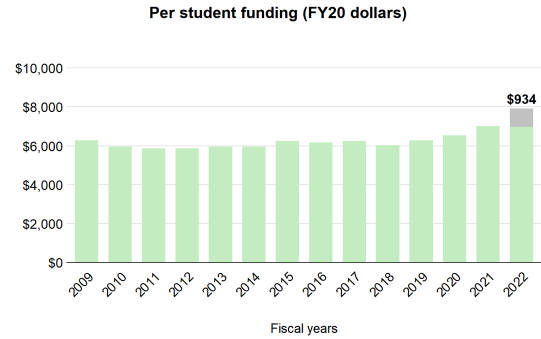
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 37 fewer teachers and instructors
- 22 more support staff
- 2 fewer school counselors and librarians
- 24 fewer teacher aides
- 1 more principals and assistant principals

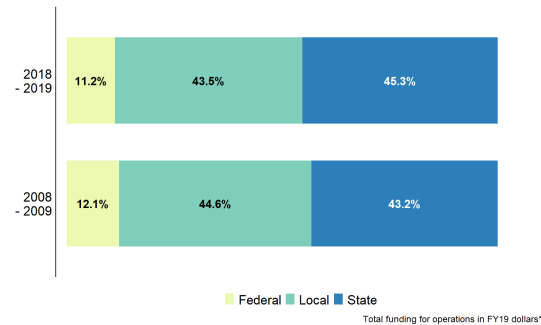
That's **40 fewer** staff overall, compared to **245 fewer** students.

## Funding

In Northampton County Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **10.9%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$934 additional dollars per student.*



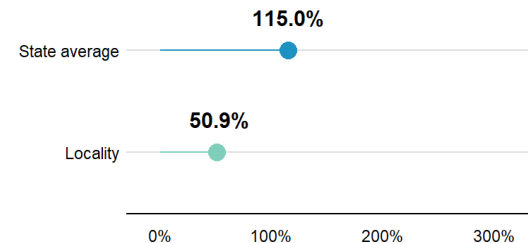
From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
