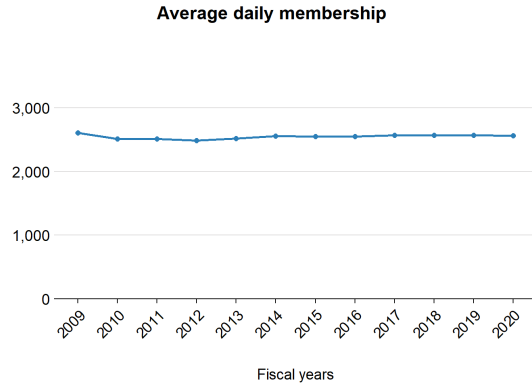


Rockbridge County Schools

This profile shows the most recent data available from the 2019-2020 school year and highlights demographics, staffing, and funding for Rockbridge County Schools.

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **down** by **1.6%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Rockbridge County Schools, compared to the state overall.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now fewer staff per student in Rockbridge County Schools.

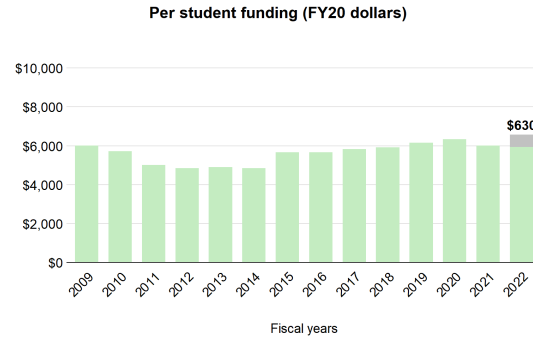
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 62 fewer teachers and instructors
- 6 fewer support staff
- 4 fewer school counselors and librarians
- 21 fewer teacher aides
- 3 fewer principals and assistant principals

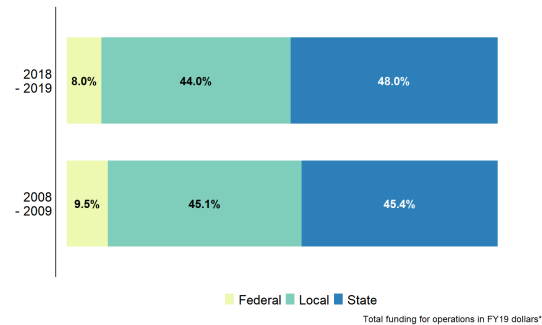
That's **96 fewer** staff overall, compared to **141 more** students.

Funding

In Rockbridge County Schools, state direct aid per student has **decreased** by **1.4%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$630 additional dollars per student.*



From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
