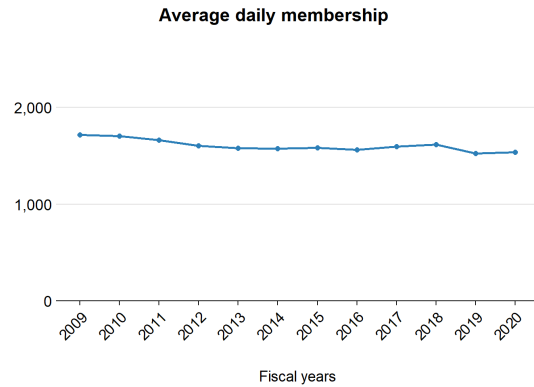


Westmoreland County Public Schools

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2019-2020 has gone **down** by **10.4%**.



Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Westmoreland County Public Schools, compared to the state overall.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, there are now more staff per student in Westmoreland County Public Schools.

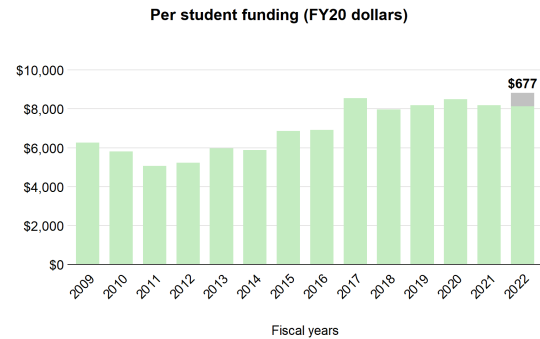
In 2018-2019, there were:

- 11 fewer teachers and instructors
- 18 more support staff
- 0 more school counselors and librarians
- 2 fewer teacher aides
- 0 more principals and assistant principals

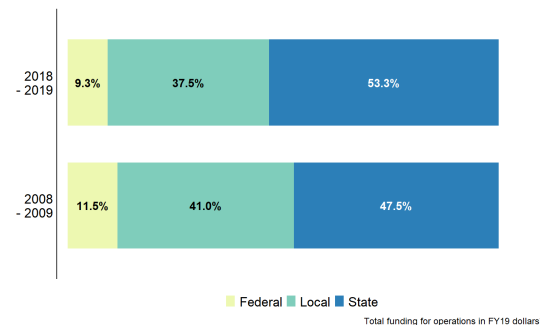
That's **4 more** staff overall, compared to **180 fewer** students.

Funding

In Westmoreland County Public Schools, state direct aid per student has **increased** by **29.8%**, adjusted for inflation. *If the revised Standards of Quality were funded in FY22, this division would receive \$677 additional dollars per student.*



From 2008-09 to 2018-19, the state's share of total funding has **increased**.
