

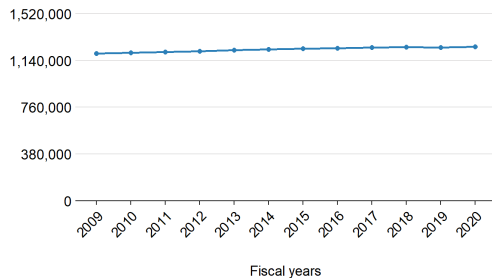
Statewide K-12 Virginia Public Schools

Students

Enrollment growth between 2008-2009 to 2021-2022 has gone **up** by **1.3%**.

Here are additional characteristics of students that go to Virginia public schools, over time.

Staffing

Compared to 2008-2009, staff per student has **decreased** in Public Schools in Virginia.

In 2020-2021, there were:

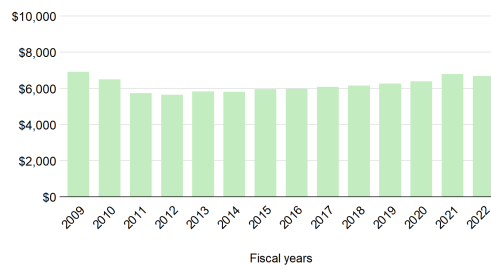
- o 1,382 more teachers and instructors
- o 3,631 fewer support staff
- o 381 more school counselors and librarians
- o 954 more teacher aides
- o 288 more principals and assistant principals

That's **626 fewer** staff overall, compared to **16,439 more** students.

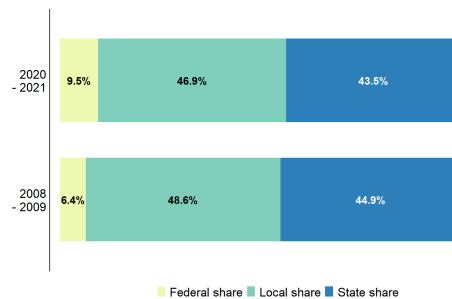
Funding

In Virginia public schools, state direct aid per student has **decreased** by **3.4%**, adjusted for inflation, since 2008-2009.

Per student funding (FY22 dollars)



From 2008-09 to 2020-21, the state's share of total funding has **decreased**. Local governments have taken on a **smaller** share of funding.



Virginia localities invested **\$4.2 billion** above what is required in the state's primary funding formula.
