

Comparing the governor's and money committee budgets to current budget

The House Appropriations and Senate Finance & Appropriations committees have released their proposed changes to the 2022-2024 budget (FYs 2023 and 2024). The charts below provide a summary level assessment of key general fund changes proposed by the money committees and Gov. Youngkin compared to the current budget (Chapter 2).
